Here are two descriptions of the candidates for Congress.

(ROTATE)

Dan Feehan is an Iraq war veteran who grew up in Red Wing. After his military service he worked as an elementary school teacher, before going back to the Department of Defense to work in the Pentagon. Dan Feehan is running for Congress because Washington is broken and the issues facing southern Minnesota are complex and challenging. Feehan says he will be an independent voice who fights for health care and prescription drug coverage that is affordable and accessible for every southern Minnesotan. That also means making sure that insurance companies are never again able to take away coverage from people with pre-existing conditions. Feehan says he supports small businesses and policies that put people first not corporate special interests.

Jim Hagedorn comes from generations of southern Minnesota farmers and he grew up helping to work the land, walk the bear fields, and feed the hogs on his parents' farm. He was elected to Congress in 2018 and serves on the Agriculture and Small business committees where he has fought hard for aid to farming communities. Jim is fighting hard to defend and protect our Constitutional values like the right to life and the Second Amendment, and to revive our economy. Jim says he will always stand behind law enforcement and will speak out to defend our way of life.

METHODOLOGY

511 complete interviews were conducted between July 19-23 with a 4.4% margin of error at the 95% confidence level.

All calls made by live professional interviewers calling from within the United States. Fifty-four percent (54%) of interviews were conducted with respondents on a wireless phone.

All interviews were conducted from a voter file sample of active registered voters who voted in either the 2016, or 2018 General Elections, or have registered since the 2018 General.
