Q1 How likely are you to vote in next November's election for Congress and other important offices? Will you definitely vote, probably vote, are the chances 50/50, or will you probably not vote?

<i>Will definitely vote</i>	96%
<i>Will probably vote</i>	4%
<i>Chances are 50/50</i>	0%
<i>Will probably not vote</i>	0%
<i>Not sure</i>	0%

Q2 I know the congressional elections are a year away, but if the vote were held today, would you vote for a Democrat or a Republican candidate?

<i>Democrat</i>	46%
<i>Republican</i>	36%
<i>Not sure</i>	18%

Q3 Do you have a favorable or unfavorable view of Congressman John Kline?

<i>Favorable</i>	32%
<i>Unfavorable</i>	42%

Q4 Regardless of how you feel about him personally, do you approve or disapprove of Congressman John Kline's job performance?

Q5 If the election for Congress were held today, would you vote for Republican Congressman John Kline or his opponent, Democratic state representative Mike Obermueller?

Q7 If you are a woman, press 1. If a man, press 2.

Q8 If you are a Democrat, press 1. If a Republican, press 2. If an independent or identify with another party, press 3.

<i>Democrat</i>	31%
<i>Republican</i>	27%
<i>Independent/Other</i>	42%

Q9 If you are Hispanic, press 1. If white, press 2. If African-American, press 3. If other, press 4.

<i>Hispanic</i>	5%
<i>White</i>	90%
<i>African-American</i>	1%
<i>Other</i>	4%

Q10 If you are 18 to 49 years old, press 1. If you are 50 or above, press 2.

<i>18 to 49</i>	38%
<i>50 or above</i>	62%





Q11 Some people say that John Kline is using his position as Chairman of the Education Committee to hurt students and families. He led the charge in Washington to allow student loan rates to double, and has repeatedly voted to cut college aid. Kline has taken nearly \$300,000 from for-profit colleges like DeVry, which have been criticized for deceiving students and veterans despite receiving billions in taxpayer funds. How much does this concern you -- a lot, a little, or not at all?
